Write a Letter to the Author. Nonfiction book reports middle school. Then the student creates a word search puzzle that includes the glossary words. What Did You Learn? They were instructed to include the following: Questions Write ten questions based on the book. On the ham slice, the student described the plot. The student defines each word and writes a sentence from the book that includes that word. After that paragraph, comes the meat of the report. Each student presented a "Book in a" project to the class. Then students in the audience have seconds to question the presenter about the book. An exception to this would be a biographical work that could work as an allegory for a greater meaning. Each student creates the front page of a newspaper that tells about events and characters in a book just read. What is a Book Report? If a student writes to an author who is still alive, you might actually mail the letter. If the presenter is able to prove in five minutes that he or she read the book, the student is excused from filing a written report about it. If that's the case, the student can share that fact after completing the speech. And then, as the result, you will have to recreate the piece of a sandwich. Use staples, a brad or a ring in order to keep the sections together at the center and the top of the pieces of a sandwich.
